It is with huge sadness that we announce the death of our Vicar, Trevor Patterson, on Tuesday 10 October following a heart attack while out running. Our Services this Sunday will be shorter than usual and will give us an opportunity to reflect and spend time together as a church family, and to pray especially for Kate, Johnny, Connor and Ben at this devastating time. They have written to us - "We are so thankful for deliveries of flowers, and feel very valued by it, but right now we are feeling slightly overwhelmed by the numbers of flowers, and may prefer them in the months and years ahead instead"

Last Sunday we showed a **video** during our Services, which reminded us of the **vision** we believe God has called us to and some of the many **groups and activities** that take place in and through the life of our church. Mark Johnston, our Treasurer, also gave us an **update on our finances**, in which he explained that we could be facing a deficit of the order of £35,000 this year and how this has come about.
