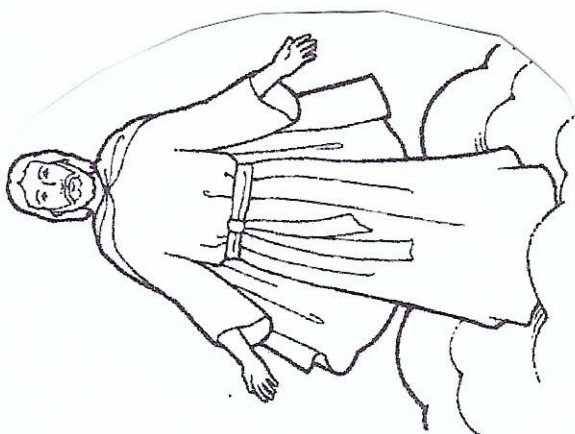


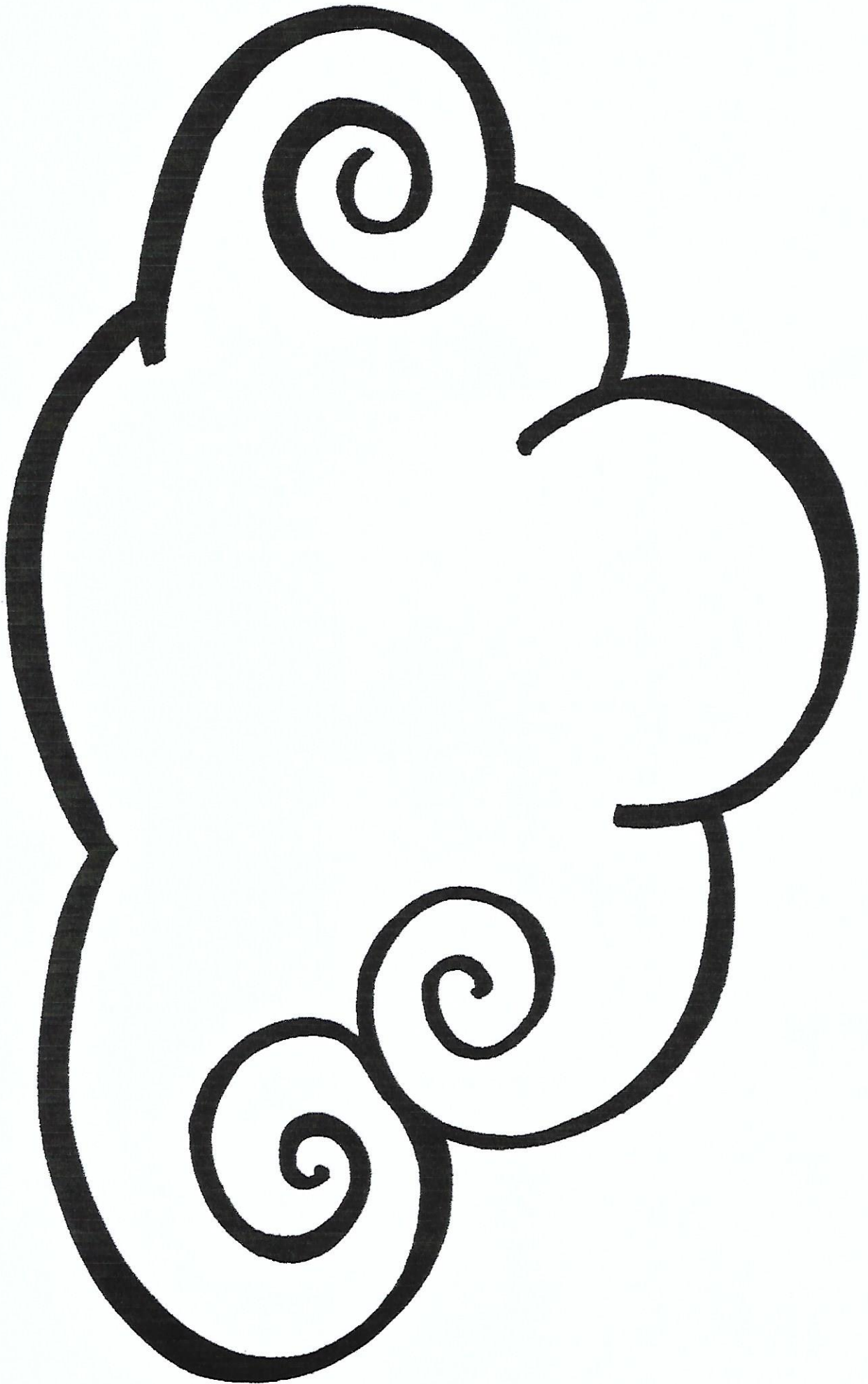
The Ascension

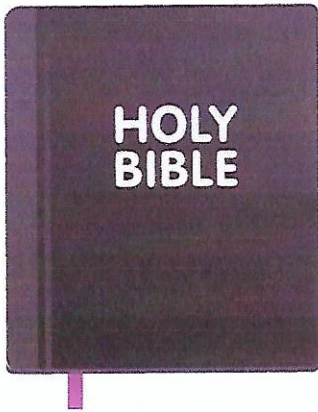
For this craft, print the cloud and Jesus. Use a hole punch to make holes in the head of Jesus and the top of the cloud. Glue cotton wool balls to the cloud shape. Thread some wool/string through both and tie to Jesus. Pull the wool/string on the cloud up to make Jesus disappear into the cloud.

It will probably be better if you glue either end of the cloud to a sheet of card or stiff paper. Remember to leave enough space for the figure of Jesus to disappear into the cloud.

Alternatively you can use a white paper cup. Colour it blue and cover it with cotton wool balls to make pretend clouds. Cut a length of string/wool, sellotape it to the figure of Jesus and thread it through a hole in the bottom of the paper cup. By pulling on the string/wool, You can then make Jesus disappear into the clouds.

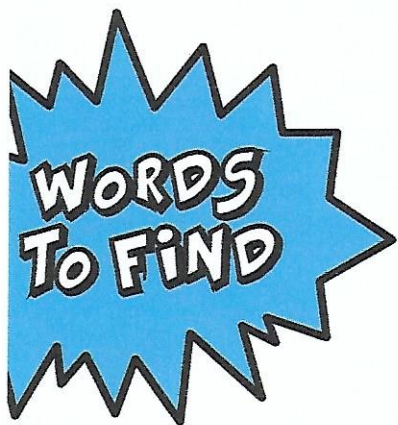
